### **Mt. Airy Water Conservation Workshop to Air on Channel 23**

**Westminster, Maryland (July 25, 2007)** ó Beginning on Wednesday, July 25, residents of Carroll County can tune in to Channel 23 for a broadcast of Mt. Airy's Water Conservation Workshop (Channel 99 for Frederick County residents within Mt. Airy town limits). The program was originally intended to run beginning in August, but given the county's drought situation the station has moved up its air time.

The workshop, held on July 21 and hosted by the Town of Mt. Airy, was put on by Citizens for the Green Mount Airy and Dan Andrews of Westminster to educate the public about simple ways to conserve water in their daily routines. Attendees were urged, among other things, to consider appliances that use less water, to limit shower time, and to wash full loads of clothes and dishes.

“Water conservation should be an ongoing policy,” said Mt. Airy Mayor Frank M. Johnson. “This is something we should consider all of the time because water is a precious resource.”

The program will air today at 9 pm and then it will run for the duration of July and throughout the month of August.
