## **Volunteers Needed for Carroll County History Project**

**Westminster, Maryland (April 23, 2009)** – The Community Media Center (CMC) is holding a Carroll County History Project volunteer training workshop on Saturday, May 16, 2009 from 10 am until 2 pm at the Community Media Center at 1301 Washington Road in Westminster. Trained volunteers interview local residents for the History Project, an initiative to document the history of the county and the memories of its residents. A component of the project, Carroll County Remembers, is a permanent video archive of interviews from those who have memories of the county.

The CMC offers training on a monthly basis that includes interviewing techniques and camera skills. The organization also coordinates interviews between History Project volunteers and Carroll County residents who are interested in sharing their memories for the archive, a permanent collection of interviews with Carroll's residents.
